CHRISTIANITY IS FOOLISH

Easter falls on the same day as April Fool's this year. It is the first time in 73 years that the coincidence has occurred. For many people the events of the first Easter seem foolish.

That Jesus died on a cross so we can be forgiven sounds barbaric. That Jesus rose from the dead to give us new life is simply unbelievable. Such reactions are not new. Less than 25 years after the events, the Bible notes:

The teaching about the cross is foolishness to those who are being lost

But many who investigated the evidence became convinced and drew a very different conclusion:

but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

Palm Crosses

The week before Easter is known as Palm Sunday.

We give out crosses made from palm leaves in our services. This commemorates Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. As He rode into the city on a donkey, His followers spread palm branches at His feet, which were symbols of victory for a

king. Through the year they remind us that Jesus' ultimate victory was through His defeat of death on the cross.

We buy African Palm Crosses made by Massai villagers of Southern Tanzania, giving them valuable extra work, economic independence and increased control over their own lives and livelihoods.



Hot Cross Buns

Though many places sell them all year round, hot cross buns are traditionally eaten on Good Friday.

The cross on the top is a reminder of the cross on which Jesus died, and the spices are a reminder of the spices used in His burial.

Every Good Friday the churches of Laleham and Staines gather outside the Two Rivers shopping centre. As well as singing, speaking and praying, we also have hundreds of hot cross buns to give away to passers-by. You might be able to spot the Vicar in this photo!

Out of the 80 million Easter eggs sold in the UK every year, The Real Easter Egg is the only one which has an Easter story book in the box, is made of Fairtrade

CANAAN: A RESOURCE ON THE HIGH STREET

Have you ever been into Canaan Christian Bookshop in Staines?

It's been on the High Street since 1979, and is a wonderful place to visit or browse. It describes itself as 'More than a bookshop! A Christian resource centre for the community'. You can buy cards and gifts, as well as books and music, and the helpful staff are always willing to advise on finding just what you're looking for. Canaan is also home to a professional Christian counselling service. After 38 years of sterling work Andy Gilmour is passing over the manager's role to Barry Mockford.



The next Bishop of London will be the Rt Revd Sarah Mullally DBE.

Bishop Sarah will be installed as the 133rd Bishop of London at St Paul's Cathedral on the 12th May.

Bishop Sarah was a senior civil servant in the Department of Health before ordination. A trained nurse, she became Chief Nursing Officer for England in 1999, the youngest person to be appointed to the post. She was ordained in 2001 initially as a self-supporting minister in Battersea, before leaving her Government post in 2004, subsequently taking up full-time ministry in Sutton.

Bishop Sarah was made a Dame Commander of the British Empire

in 2005 in recognition of her outstanding contribution to nursing and midwifery.

Bishop Sarah said: *"It is a great honour to be nominated to the See of London. Having lived and worked in London for over 32 years, the thought of returning here is about returning home. I am often asked what it has been like to have had two careers, first in the NHS and now in the Church. I prefer to think that I have always had one vocation: to follow Jesus Christ, to know him and to make him known, always seeking to live with compassion in the service of others, whether as a nurse, a priest, or a bishop. To be given the opportunity to do that now in this vibrant world-city is a wonderful privilege."*
