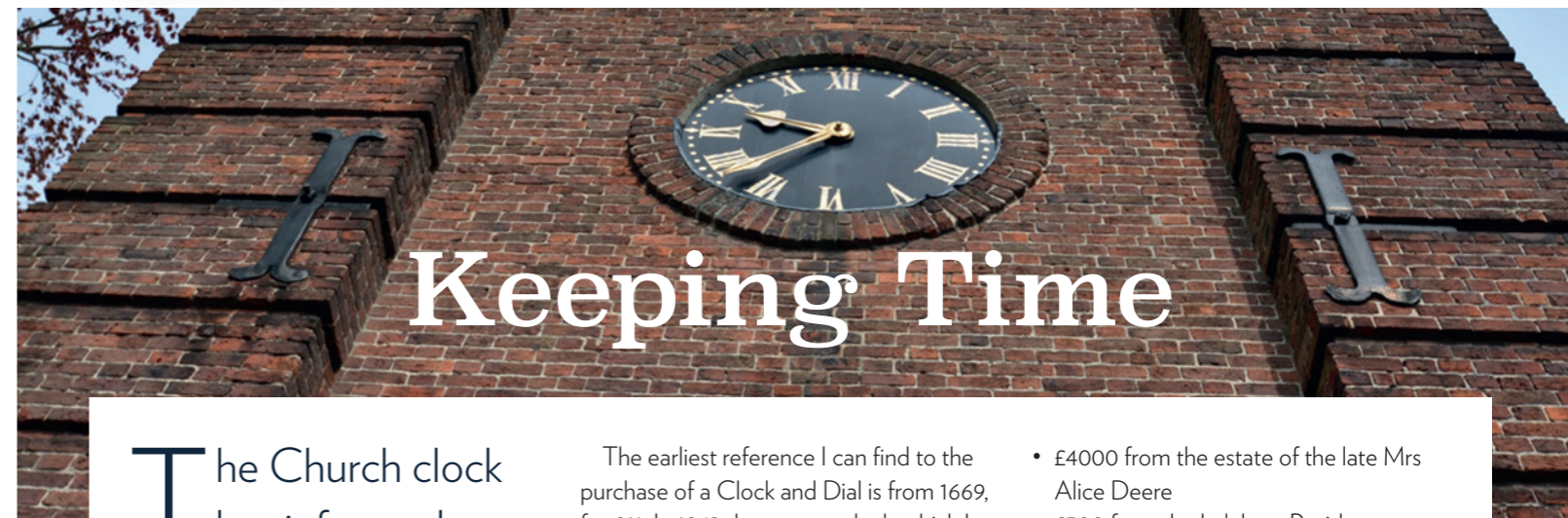

JOY

A unique free event at Kempton Park to which all are welcome. Come and enjoy a morning of celebration attended by churches across Spelthorne. A festival for all ages, with bands, speakers and children's events - culminating in a free meal using leftover food collected from local shops. Starts at 10am.



The Church clock has informed Laleham villagers of the time for many centuries.

The earliest reference I can find to the purchase of a Clock and Dial is from 1669, for £11. In 1842 the present clock, which has a 4ft copper dial, was given to the Church. Over the coming months the clock will be automated, including a regulator that should ensure accuracy and adjustment for Summer Time.

We are very grateful to a number of donors who have given generously towards this project:

- £4000 from the estate of the late Mrs Alice Deere
- £500 from the Laleham Residents Association
- £160 from Spelthorne Borough Council via Councillor Mary Madams
- Once a faculty has been given (a sort of planning permission for churches) the work will be carried out by the Cumbria Clock Company who are currently working on 'Big Ben'!

Laleham Churchyard

Laleham Churchyard is a lovely area at the heart of the village, and the many tended plots are a testimony to love and special memories.

There are rules for tending the churchyard which reflect three guiding principles:

- To maintain a dignified environment that can be appreciated by all
- To ensure the safety and care of the churchyard
- To follow the rules set down by the Diocese of London

The full wording of the Churchyard Policy, which has been updated, is in the Church porch or available from the Church Office.

The policy includes:

Flowers

On cremated remains plots only cut flowers or small potted plants are permitted, which may be placed on the gravestone, or in a vase integrated into the gravestone. Artificial flowers are not permitted, with the exception of Remembrance Day poppies and Christmas wreaths.

Given the limitations of space, shrubs may not be planted.

On burial plots with a grass surface the grass should be left to allow for mowing.

Individuality

Unfortunately the introduction of any additional objects, such as model angels or birds, lights or chimes, are not authorised.



We will shortly be removing items from the churchyard which do not conform to the Churchyard Policy. All items removed will be labelled with the family name where possible, and carefully stored for 3 months. Families can collect the items if they wish. Please contact the Church Office to arrange collections.

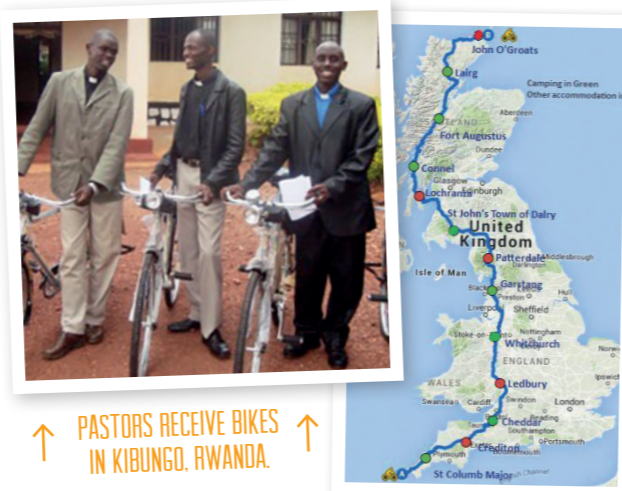
The PCC note: "We recognise that some people may feel frustrated by the limitations, but our hope is that this will enable the widest number of people to gain the greatest benefit from the peace and beauty of the churchyard."

BIKES FOR PASTORS

According to the famous signposts at Land's End and John O'Groats, the most direct route by road is 874 miles.

The Vicar will be taking a rather longer route, hoping to cycle 1100 miles over 12 days in June, along with All Saints' member, Simon Williams. The route is similar to that on the map, taking minor roads and travelling up the west coast of Scotland and includes a detour via the Inner Hebrides.
