All started well. Despite seemingly endless hills through Cornwall and Devon, progress was steady and even the occasional shower didn't dampen the

spirits. However towards the end of Day 2 his achilles began to ache. Andy writes 'the next morning I could only really cycle with one leg. With great disappointment I decided to abandon. My riding partner Simon Williams was made of tougher stuff and carried on.

Despite the frustration of not being able to continue, my generous sponsors kindly agreed to still donate, and £1,765 was raised for Bikes for Pastors in East Africa'.

Tori shares some of her story:

'I am married to Joe and have 3 girls; Talei and twins Lilibet and Litiana. I grew up in a Christian family and had a strong faith from a very early age.

We started attending All Saints' in Laleham after we moved into the area. We wanted to find a local church that we didn't just attend for an hour or so on a Sunday morning and leave, but one that would become family to us. It was evident from the first week we attended, that All Saints' was a Church that would welcome us and accept us; somewhere where we could belong.

Like most people, my life has not always been plain sailing. However whatever problems, issues and heartache I have faced God has always been there, not to take the problems away, but He has given me peace, and a strength to get through the difficult times, and then has used the mistakes, the hurt, the wrongs to bring about something good. My favourite verse from the Bible has always been "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding, in all your ways acknowledge him and he will direct your paths".

Confirmation was a way for me to show publicly my commitment to God and to thank him for everything he has done for me. It was such a powerful and moving experience.
