



I started to seek God in different religions but none of them could offer me a personal relationship with Him.

When I totally lost my hope about finding God, a friend told me "if you call Jesus' name He will answer you. He is not a dead prophet, He is the living God!" Although it sounded utterly unacceptable to my mind, a new hope came to my heart about finding God and I started reading the Gospel on the same

I became a Christian by reading the Sermon on the Mount and experiencina Jesus' love, forgiveness and compassion while I was studying Biotechnology in university."
